




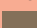


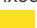

FROM THE CEO'S DESK

Dear Friends,

As the English New year begins, the hopes in India of a sound economic recovery are high on the back of the majority the new government commands in the Lok Sabha and the Pro-business stance of the new Prime Minister.

With all these expectations the Indian Stock Markets have been running up to create new highs. Globally, however the signals have been mixed as far as the different asset classes are concerned. Gold has been more or less stable, equities have been doing well in the US, the greenback has been strengthening and the commodities have been weakening. Most notably OIL has crashed by more than 50% in the past 6 months and touched price levels which prevailed in 2008.



The dramatic fall in Oil has been the story in the recent past. All countries which export oil have been at a disadvantage and countries which import oil have been benefited. India is one of the biggest beneficiaries of this fall. On the other hand Russia and Venezuela have been the worst hit because of the unexpected steep decline in the prices of crude oil.

India has been one of the biggest beneficiaries of the downward movement in Oil prices and we expect that if the Oil prices remain at the current level or at sub USD 50 per barrel, India would be in an excellent position to reduce its Current Account Deficit to near zero levels which will be remarkable for us.

In the year gone by, the expectations of a rate cut from RBI continued. The RBI did not oblige but may oblige in the 2015. The question is when in 2015?

In the year gone by, we saw the BJP replacing the Congress and its allies in the Central Government. We also saw BJP coming to power in all states where elections were held barring Karnataka. Globally we saw the US economic recovery gaining ground, we saw the European Union committed to keep its members united, we saw Japan and China slow down and most unfortunately we saw the terrorism posing new challenges to the Global world.

The single most unfortunate event in the world in 2014 was the rise of ISIS in Syria and Iraq which was a shot in the arm to the terrorist forces across the world.

2015 begins with promises yet the challenges remain. If the Indian Central Government walks the talk, which the BJP spoke about before the elections Indian will gain by miles. The investors and the Asset managers do seem to have the confidence that this government will deliver.

Should that happen, 2015 and the next few years will be a period which none of the investors should miss upon to create wealth.

We wish everyone a remarkable period of wealth creation in 2015 and beyond.

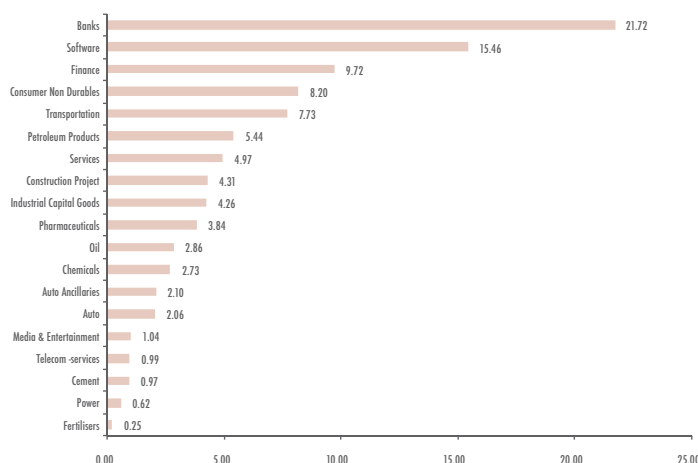

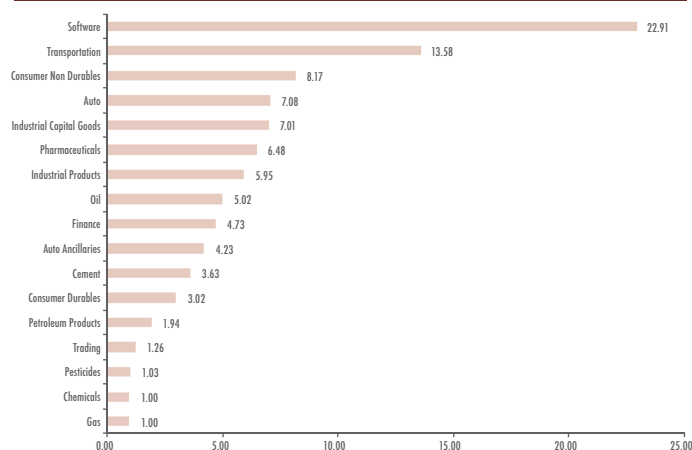

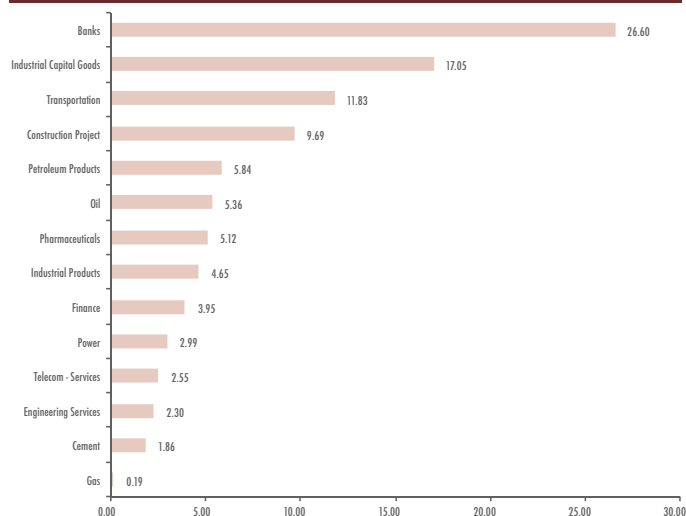

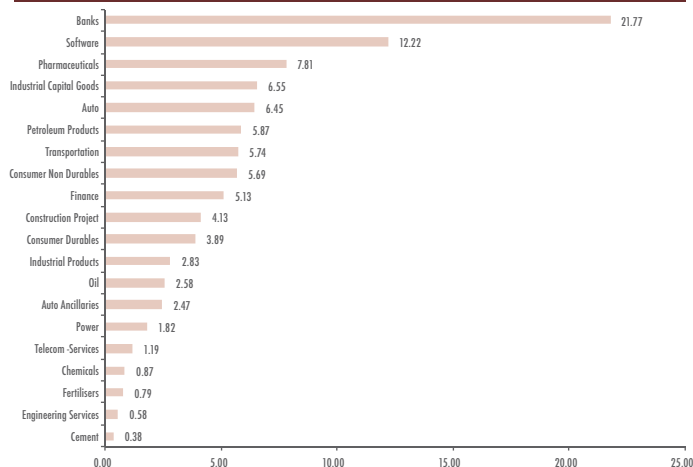

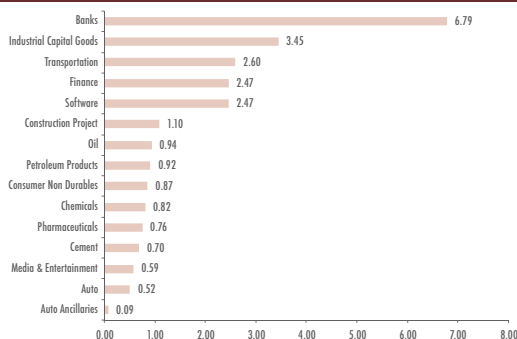
