







FROM THE CEO'S DESK

Dear Friends,

The first quarter of the new Financial year was the time when the election campaigning was the most visible activity in the country. The outgoing Congress Government had tried taking strong steps, albeit pretty late in the day to reduce the Fiscal Deficit, Current Account Deficit and the inflation. The electorate was however in no mood to overlook the broader omissions and lack of decisive policy measures which hall marked the first 3/3.5 years of the second term (2009-2014) of the Congress Rule.

While it was expected that the BJP will romp home this time, it came as a pleasant surprise that the election results gave a clear majority to the BJP. This is not only expected to give them the necessary freedom to execute their decisions to put the economy on a strong growth path but also places an additional responsibility on them since now there cannot be any excuse for mis-governance or lack of governance.

On the Economic Front, Globally the US and the Europe have been stable and seem determined to ensure that they do not suffer any setbacks. The various different US economic data points have been pointing sometimes to a growth and sometimes stagnancy, however have not been a cause for worry. China has slowed down to an extent but is still growing at a better pace than the rest of the world. The emerging markets have been having their own slowdown but still remain the engine of growth for the world.

On the Domestic front, we have seen high inflows from FIIs into the Indian Stock Markets on the back of the expectation of a clear mandate in favour of a decisive government. This has driven the Indian Stock Markets to life time highs without much change on the ground. It is unfair also to expect the Government to change things so quickly. Hence we are positive that as and when the Government starts taking steps to improve things, after some consolidation the markets will start moving up again.

Expectations from the Government include liberalizing procedures to invest in India, job creation, reducing inflation (whatever of it is in the control of the Government), reducing the Fiscal and Current account Deficits apart from improving infrastructure.

Talking of inflation, with the Monsoon in India playing truant, the chances of an immediate reduction in inflation have drifted slightly away and this in turn means that reduction in interest rates from the RBI may not be expected in the immediate future.

Overall, we have seen Gold decline slightly (which happens when one sees some stability returning), debt markets holding their ground and equity markets moving to life time highs with further upside potential.

All things seem to be pointing towards a better future. The only joker in the pack seems to be the Geo-Political crisis unfolding in the Middle east, especially in Syria and Iraq which has the potential of snow balling into something more serious and in turn dragging some other countries of Middle East and their allies into the quagmire.

The pluses still outweigh the negatives by a huge margin. Time to continue investing!!

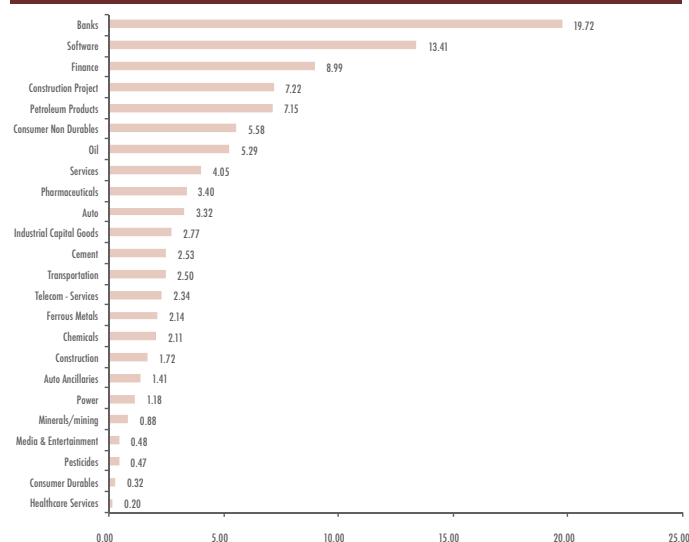

The recent effort in pushing massive infrastructure project has induced positive sentiments in the sector. The significant policy reforms in coal, gas and power sector is providing significant boost to the sectors future outlook. Sector has been under pressure since last few years due to multiple factors. 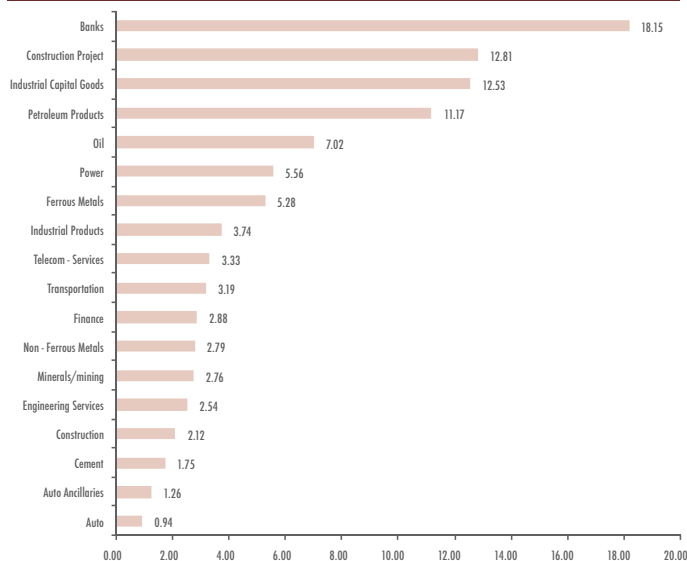

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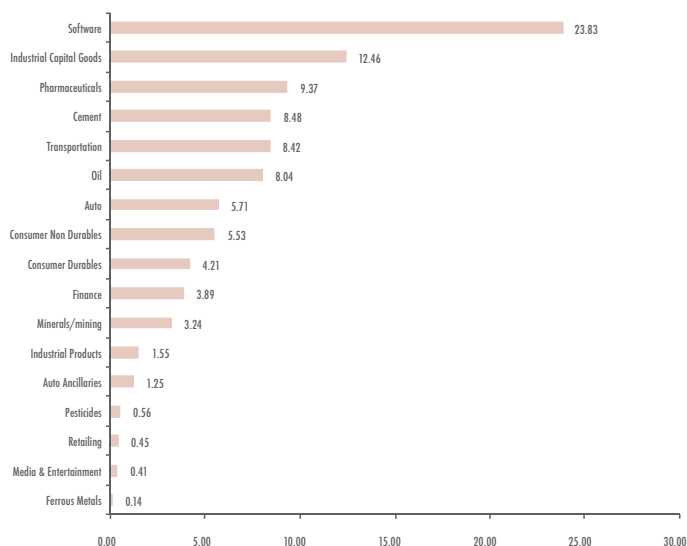

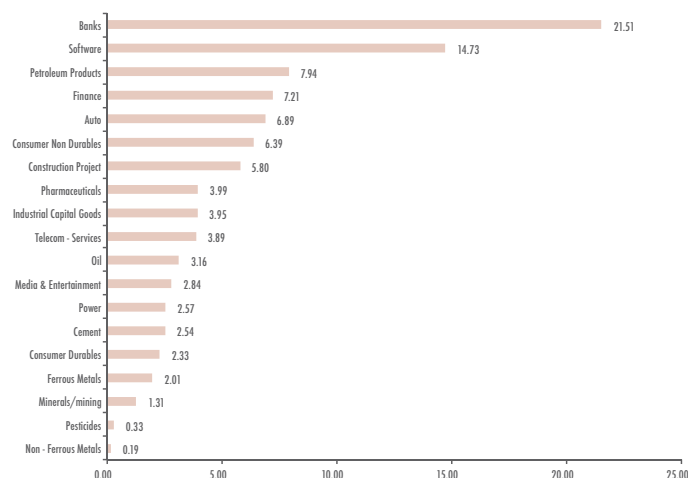

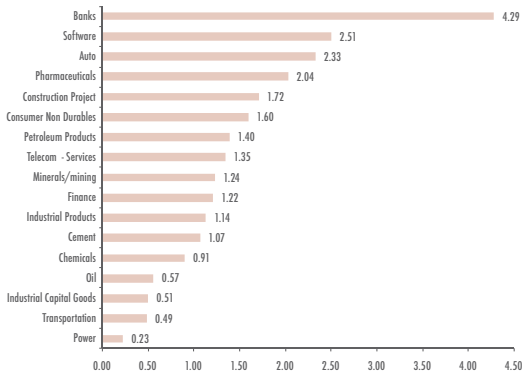
