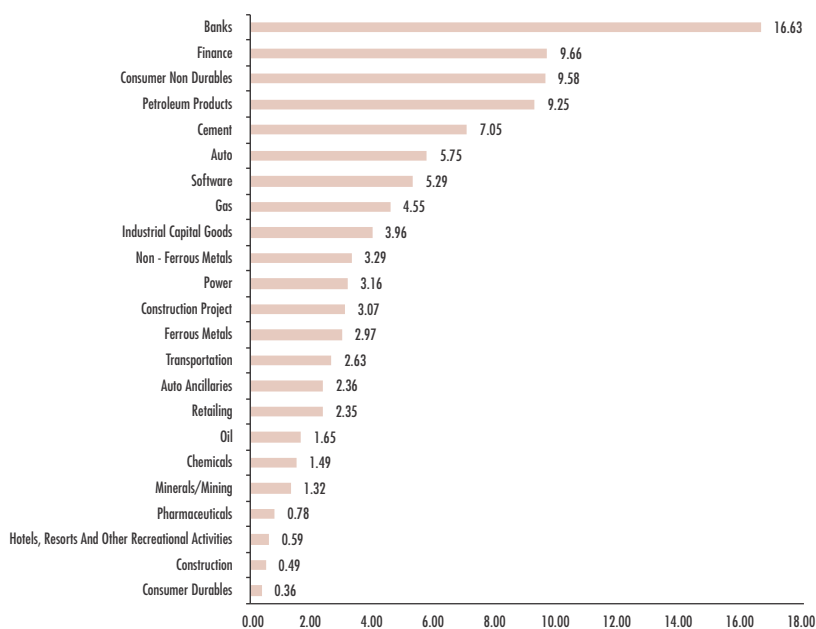

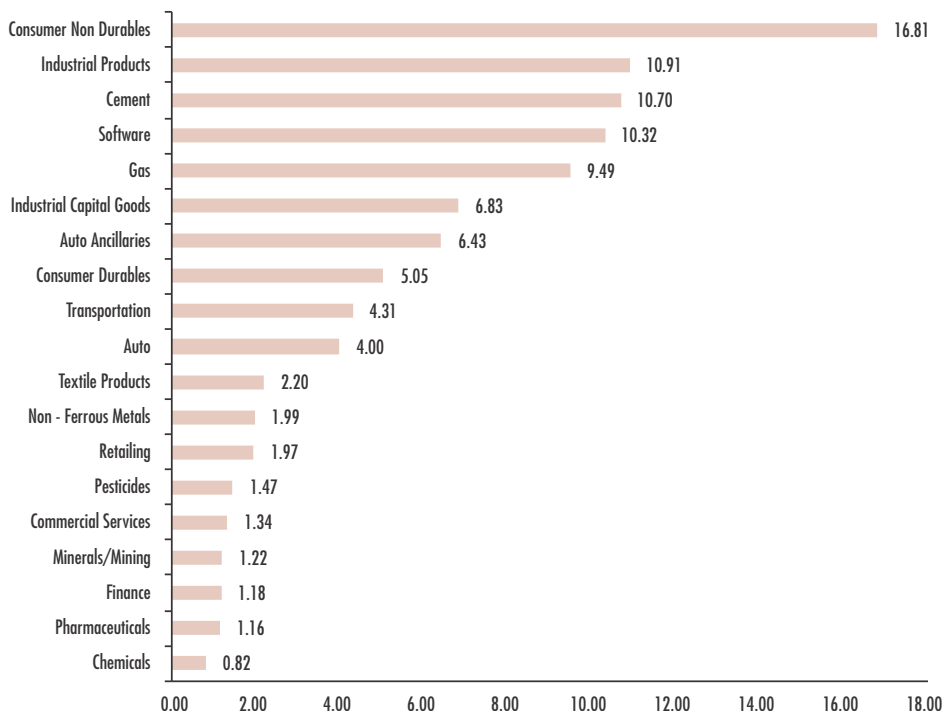

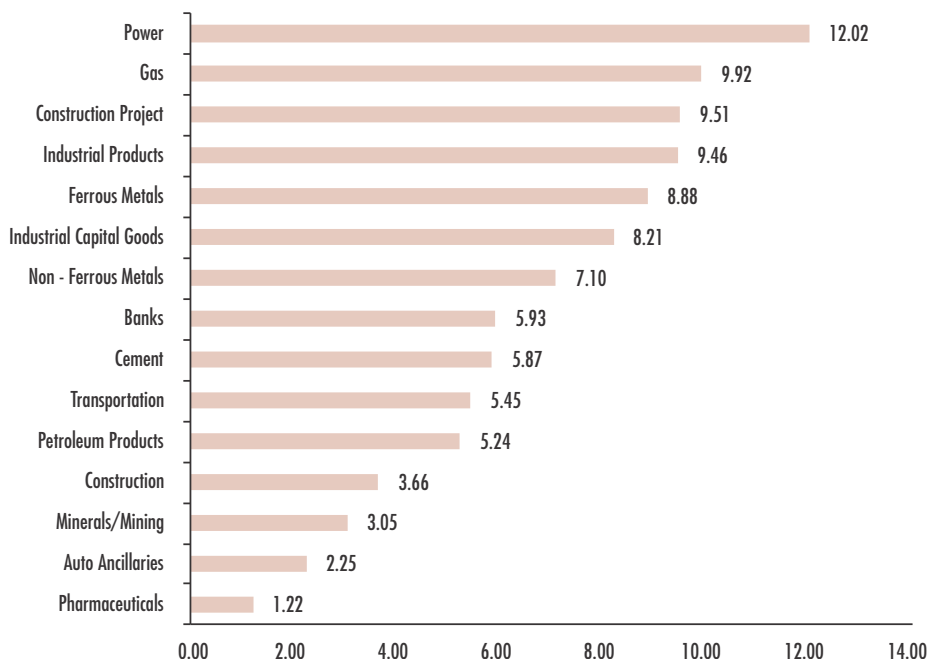

Fund Manager's Comment (Equity Schemes):

Bank recap was one of the key theme/reform that emerged this month. The recapitalisation amount seems adequate and may create a supportive environment for growth. The rise in crude oil prices has put downward pressure on Indian equities recently. Rationalisation of GST rates is also likely to be positive for markets.

Domestic flows continue to be robust in October at ~US\$ 1.5bn (~US\$2.7bn September). Domestic flows continue to outpace foreign flows and provide support to the market.

On earnings front, while some companies witnessed post-GST restocking-led volume recovery, others are yet to recover fully. This possibly also reflects the demand environment generally. Based on the results reported so far, many companies appear to have focused on cost control during the quarter. Since the start of the earnings season, FY 18/19 consensus Nifty earnings estimates have been revised higher by 1/1% (vs 8/4% cuts 2017 YTD). This is not broad-based though.

Going ahead, developments in US will be keenly watched. There are concerns on US President Donald Trump's ability to deliver his economic agenda. Also, markets remains edgy on the pace of the rate-hike cycle in US. Other key global event to watch will be crude prices and geo-political tensions. Domestically; RBI stance on interest rates, earnings and pick-up in investment/ capex cycle will be keenly watched.

Fund Manager's Comment (Debt Schemes):

Some of the significant developments in October 2017 were as under:

- The government announced a recapitalization program for public sector banks to be implemented over two years. The total recapitalization is expected to be INR 2.1 tn out of which 1.35 tn would likely come from recapitalization bonds and the remaining through budgetary support.
- The move to recapitalize public sector banks has been welcomed all around as it gives the banks leeway in managing their large non performing assets (npas) while maintaining adequate capital. The RBI governor has stated that it is unlikely to create monetary or fiscal stress.
- Bond yields hardened a bit on the lack of a clear roadmap on policy rates and hawkish comments by at least one monetary policy committee member. Yield on benchmark 10 year government bonds closed the month at 6.86%.
- International oil prices too hit a two year high with the benchmark ICE Brent contract crossing the psychological USD 60 per barrel mark.
- Inflation data for the month of September was released mid month. Inflation based on consumer prices (CPI) came in at 3.28%. This was well below market expectations of a 3.9% print. Inflation based on WPI also came in softer than expected at 2.6%. Expectations were of the rate being 3.3%. Lower food prices helped keep inflation in check.
- Index of industrial production (IIP) for August came in at a much better than expected 4.3% aided by a 9.4% gain in mining and a 3.1% gain in manufacturing.
- Earlier, RBI's interest rate setting monetary policy committee (MPC) decided to leave the policy repo rate unchanged at 6%. The committee also voted 5 to 1 to maintain the "neutral" stance on monetary policy. Only Prof Dholakia voted for a 25 basis point reduction in policy rates.
- RBI has however reduced the statutory liquidity ratio (SLR) from 20% to 19.5%. This reduces the amount of pre-emption (of bank deposits) by the government. Additionally, the ceiling on government securities kept in the held to maturity (HTM) segment has also been reduced from 20.25% to 19.5% in a phased manner till March 31, 2018.
- The central bank has however cut their forecast for gross value add (GVA) for FY 18 to 6.7% from the earlier forecast of 7.3%.

How to read Factsheet

Fund Manager : An employee of the asset management company such as a mutual fund or life insurer, who manages investments of the scheme. He is usually part of a larger team of fund managers and research analysts.

Application Amount for Fresh Subscription : This is the minimum investment amount for a new investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Minimum Additional Amount : This is the minimum investment amount for an existing investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Yield to Maturity : The Yield to Maturity or the YTM is the rate of return anticipated on a bond if held until maturity. YTM is expressed as an annual rate. The YTM factors in the bond's current market price, par value, coupon interest rate and time to maturity.

SIP : SIP or systematic investment plan works on the principle of making periodic investments of a fixed sum. It works similar to a recurring bank deposit. For instance, an investor may opt for an SIP that invests Rs. 500 every 15th of the month in an equity fund for a period of three years.

NAV : The NAV or the net asset value is the total asset value per unit of the mutual fund after deducting all related and permissible expenses. The NAV is calculated at the end of every business day. It is the value at which the investor enters or exits the mutual fund.

Benchmark : A group of securities, usually a market index, whose performance is used as a standard or benchmark to measure investment performance of mutual funds, among other investments. Some typical benchmarks include the Nifty, Sensex, BSE200, BSE500, 10 - Year Gsec.

Entry Load : A Mutual fund may have a sales charge or load at the time of entry and/or exit to compensate the distributor/agent.

Entry load is charged at the time an investor purchases the units of a mutual fund. The entry load is added to the prevailing NAV at the time of investment. For instance, if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the entry load is 1%, the investor will enter the fund at Rs. 101

Note: SEBI, vide circular dated June 30, 2009 has abolished entry load and mandated that upfront commission to distributors will be paid by the investor directly to the distributor, based on his assessment of various factors including the service rendered by the distributor.

Exit Load : Exit load is charged at the time an investor redeems the units of a mutual fund. The exit load is reduced from the prevailing NAV at the time of redemption. The investor will receive redemption proceed at net value of NAV less Exit Load. For instance if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the exit load is 1% the investor will receive Rs. 99.

Modified Duration : Modified duration is the price sensitivity and the percentage change in price for a unit change in yield

Standard Deviation : Standard deviation is a statistical measure of the range of an investment's performance. When a mutual fund has a high standard deviation, it means its range of performance is wide, implying greater volatility.

Sharp Ratio : The Sharp Ratio, named after its founder, the Nobel Laureate William Sharpe, is a measure of risk-adjusted returns. It is calculated using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk.

Beta : Beta is a measure of an investment's volatility vis-a-vis the market. Beta of less than 1 means that the security will be less volatile than the market. A beta of greater than 1 implies that the security's price will be more volatile than the market.

AUM : AUM or assets under management refers to the recent / updated cumulative market value of investments managed by a mutual fund or any investment firm.

Holdings : The holdings or the portfolio is a mutual fund's latest or updated reported statement of investments/securities. These are usually displayed in terms of percentage to net assets or the rupee value or both. The objective is to give investors an idea of where their money is being invested by the fund manager.

Nature of Scheme : The investment objective and underlying investments determine the nature of the mutual fund scheme. For instance, a mutual fund or growth fund. Likewise, a mutual fund that aims at capital preservation by investing in debt markets is a debt fund or income fund. Each of these categories may have sub-categories.

Rating Profile : Mutual funds invest in securities after evaluating their creditworthiness as disclosed by the rating. A depiction of the mutual fund in various investments based on their ratings becomes the rating profile of the fund. Typically, this is a feature of debt funds.
