FROM THE INVESTMENT DESK

Dear Investors,

GDP growth data for the first quarter of this financial year (April-June 2017) came in at a relatively weak 5.7% against an expectation of 6.3%. Lingering effects of last year's demonetization and the impact of impending implementation of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) during that quarter seemed to have been responsible for the sluggishness in growth.

While the Reserve Bank of India's monetary policy committee (MPC) did reduce interest rates by 25 basis points in the preceding quarter, the market seems to have been expecting more. Some argue that RBI's policies have made the country endure a relatively high real interest rate (since inflation has been relatively modest @ about 3%). This has also led to the Indian rupee display relative strength in the currency markets which in turn impacts growth by discouraging exports in favour of imports. RBI's reluctance to adopt an accommodative stance on monetary policy (instead of the "neutral" stance that they have adopted now) has also meant that market interest rates have risen in the past quarter. 10 year government bond yields have risen by at least 30-35 basis points (0.30%-0.35%) in this period.



The implementation of the new GST regime has not been without its hiccups. While it is universally acknowledged that a value added tax regime like the GST is desirable, most of the pain has been witnessed in its implementation, especially the IT backbone. GST systems have become the new 'bugbear' of the corporate world, with a lot of time and energy of entrepreneurs and managements going towards sorting out trivial matters arising out of the "invoice matching" mechanism that the government has chosen to implement. The silver lining in all this has been the government's willingness to listen and adapt to the unfolding environment. We believe that these are mostly teething issues which are likely to go away once businesses become familiar with and adapt to the new GST regime. One thing is certain - GST is here to stay and there is no going back.

The quarterly results due this month would be the first that companies would announce after the implementation of the GST regime. In special focus would be the results coming out of the banking sector which is in the grip of an NPA crisis as non performing assets mount. RBI's strict stance on this has also meant that banks are forced to acknowledge the seriousness of the problem and take corrective action. The new insolvency resolution process under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) is likely to be tested to its limits. We will have to wait and see if the quicker judicial process envisaged under the IBC ensures satisfactory resolution.

The GST regime and the revised insolvency resolution process should provide a launchpad for a bigger and more efficient growth of the economy in the future. Businesses may take some time to adapt to the new environment but once familiarity with the new processes set in, we should witness a significant jump in growth rates, especially in view of the large infrastructure spend planned by the government.

All said, it should be good times for investors in the next few months to come.

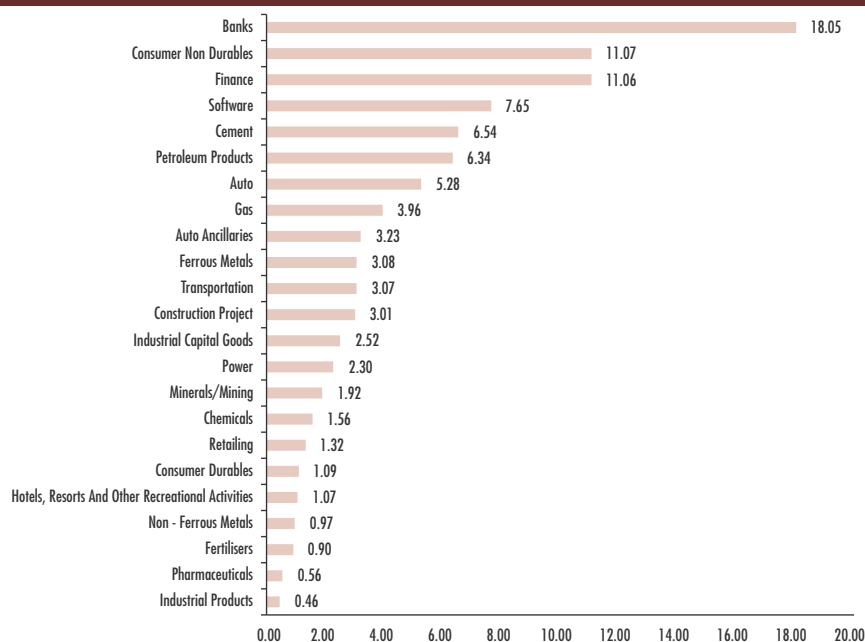

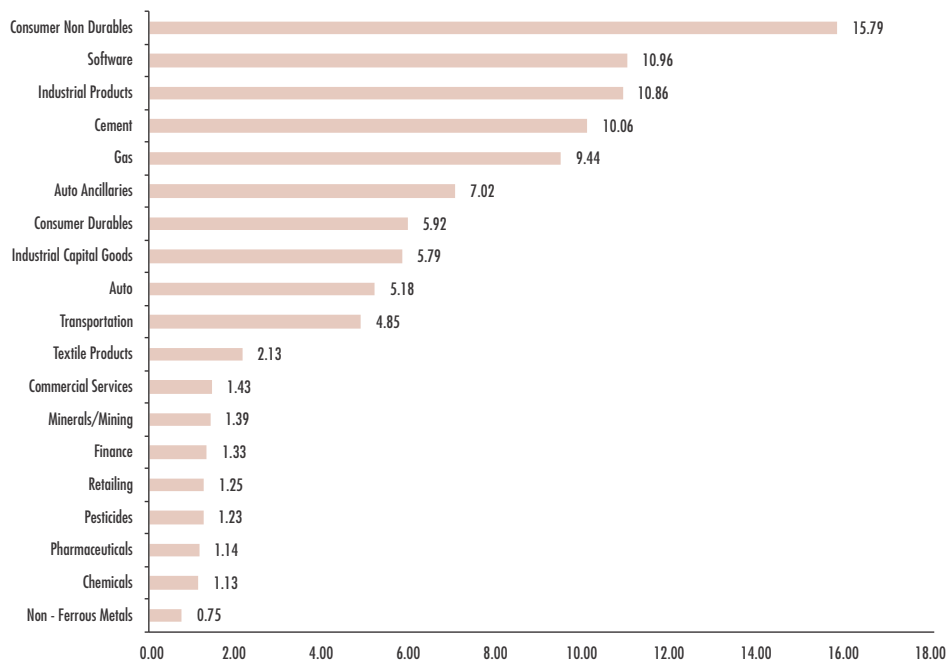

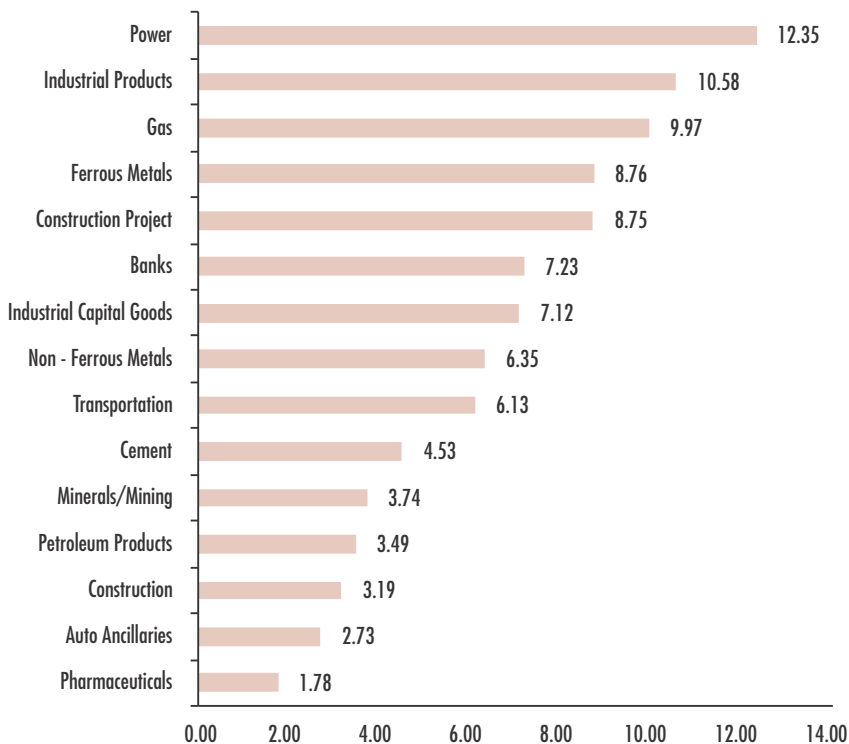

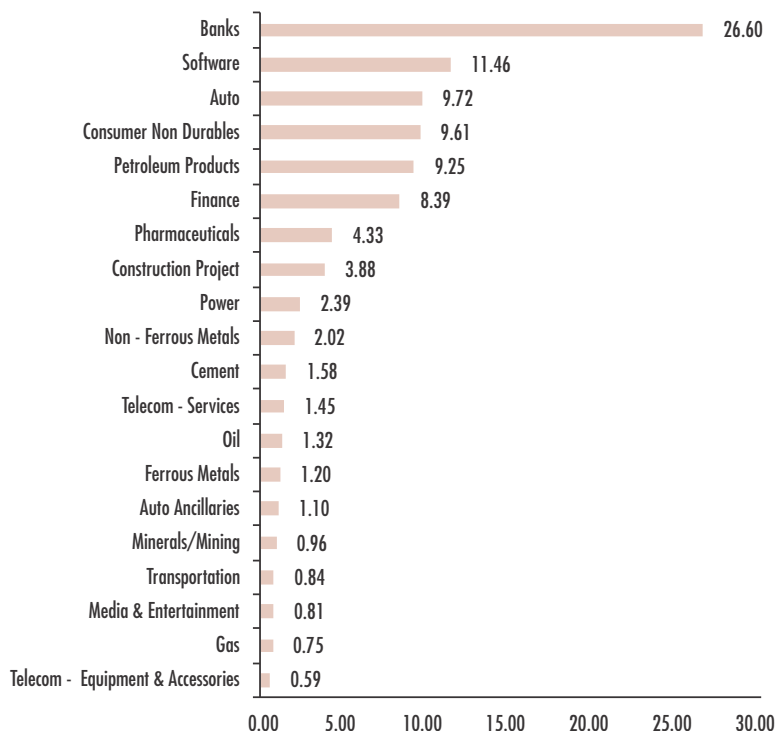

The sustained regulatory change and positive policy frame work coupled with economic recovery should prove to be tailwind for the stocks in the BFSI sector. The Indian government's ambitious target of doubling farm income by 2022 should benefit stocks in the rural theme. Increase in weight in the cyclical commodity sector is tactical in nature.

Sensex and Nifty went down by 447 points (-1.4%) and 129 points (-1.3%) to close at 31283.72 and 9788.60 respectively. BSE Small (+0.8%) and mid-caps (+0.7%) outperformed.

Equity markets saw consolidation over the past month given: a) geopolitical tensions pertaining to North Korea's weapon tests, b) higher crude prices putting pressure on macro-economic variables, c) credit rating downgrade of China/Hong Kong d) moderating rate cut expectations given the recent spike in inflation, and e) concerns on widening fiscal deficit with 96% of the fiscal deficit target achieved in Apr-Aug 17 vs. average 75% in previous three years.

Going ahead, market will continue to focus on policy decisions in US along with its balance sheet unwinding. OPEC's move to tighten global supplies may continue to keep oil prices on an uptrend. Domestically, markets are likely to focus on the upcoming RBI policy, government's plan to revive the growth in economy as well as Q2FY18 results.

Fund Manager's Comment (Debt Schemes):

The month of September began with geo-political tensions due to North Korea's nuclear test taking center-stage.

Bond markets were therefore nervous and edgy. Additionally,

The central government's fiscal deficit was shown to have reached 96% of its yearly target.

Inflation based on CPI for the month of August jumped sharply to 3.36% pa from 2.36% pa print seen in the previous month. Analysts have attributed this increase to the advent of the GST regime and the house rent allowance adjustment under the 7th pay commission.

Inflation based on the wholesale price index (WPI) also registered a sharp increase to 3.24% p.a. This compares to the 1.88% print that was witnessed in July.

The index for industrial production (IIP) saw a modest growth of 1.2% for the month of July. It had seen a fall of 0.1% in the month of June.

Strong rupee led to buoyant imports relative to exports leading to a rise in the country's current account deficit (CAD). For Q1 in FY 2017-18 the CAD came in at \$ 14.3 bn. This compares with \$3.4 bn deficit witnessed in the previous quarter.

Higher inflation numbers and geopolitical tensions due to N Korea's nuclear test and missile launch meant that bond markets displayed jittery behaviour. Yield on the benchmark 10 year government security crossed the 7.65% levels.

The US Federal Reserve confirmed that it was withdrawing the monetary support (through bond purchases) that it had been providing so far and indicated that it will start reducing its balance sheet beginning October.

The Fed statement was judged as "hawkish" by the market with a greater likelihood of a rate increase in December.

How to read Factsheet

Fund Manager : An employee of the asset management company such as a mutual fund or life insurer, who manages investments of the scheme. He is usually part of a larger team of fund managers and research analysts.

Application Amount for Fresh Subscription : This is the minimum investment amount for a new investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Minimum Additional Amount : This is the minimum investment amount for an existing investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Yield to Maturity : The Yield to Maturity or the YTM is the rate of return anticipated on a bond if held until maturity. YTM is expressed as an annual rate. The YTM factors in the bond's current market price, par value, coupon interest rate and time to maturity.

SIP : SIP or systematic investment plan works on the principle of making periodic investments of a fixed sum. It works similar to a recurring bank deposit. For instance, an investor may opt for an SIP that invests Rs. 500 every 15th of the month in an equity fund for a period of three years.

NAV : The NAV or the net asset value is the total asset value per unit of the mutual fund after deducting all related and permissible expenses. The NAV is calculated at the end of every business day. It is the value at which the investor enters or exits the mutual fund.

Benchmark : A group of securities, usually a market index, whose performance is used as a standard or benchmark to measure investment performance of mutual funds, among other investments. Some typical benchmarks include the Nifty, Sensex, BSE200, BSE500, 10 - Year Gsec.

Entry Load : A Mutual fund may have a sales charge or load at the time of entry and/or exit to compensate the distributor/agent.

Entry load is charged at the time an investor purchases the units of a mutual fund. The entry load is added to the prevailing NAV at the time of investment. For instance, if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the entry load is 1%, the investor will enter the fund at Rs. 101

Note: SEBI, vide circular dated June 30, 2009 has abolished entry load and mandated that upfront commission to distributors will be paid by the investor directly to the distributor, based on his assessment of various factors including the service rendered by the distributor.

Exit Load : Exit load is charged at the time an investor redeems the units of a mutual fund. The exit load is reduced from the prevailing NAV at the time of redemption. The investor will receive redemption proceed at net value of NAV less Exit Load. For instance if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the exit load is 1% the investor will receive Rs. 99.

Modified Duration : Modified duration is the price sensitivity and the percentage change in price for a unit change in yield

Standard Deviation : Standard deviation is a statistical measure of the range of an investment's performance. When a mutual fund has a high standard deviation, it means its range of performance is wide, implying greater volatility.

Sharp Ratio : The Sharp Ratio, named after its founder, the Nobel Laureate William Sharpe, is a measure of risk-adjusted returns. It is calculated using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk.

Beta : Beta is a measure of an investment's volatility vis-a-vis the market. Beta of less than 1 means that the security will be less volatile than the market. A beta of greater than 1 implies that the security's price will be more volatile than the market.

AUM : AUM or assets under management refers to the recent / updated cumulative market value of investments managed by a mutual fund or any investment firm.

Holdings : The holdings or the portfolio is a mutual fund's latest or updated reported statement of investments/securities. These are usually displayed in terms of percentage to net assets or the rupee value or both. The objective is to give investors an idea of where their money is being invested by the fund manager.

Nature of Scheme : The investment objective and underlying investments determine the nature of the mutual fund scheme. For instance, a mutual fund or growth fund. Likewise, a mutual fund that aims at capital preservation by investing in debt markets is a debt fund or income fund. Each of these categories may have sub-categories.

Rating Profile : Mutual funds invest in securities after evaluating their creditworthiness as disclosed by the rating. A depiction of the mutual fund in various investments based on their ratings becomes the rating profile of the fund. Typically, this is a feature of debt funds.
